Regulations such as the Toxic Substances Control Act and REACH require brands and retailers to know what hazardous chemicals can be found in their products.

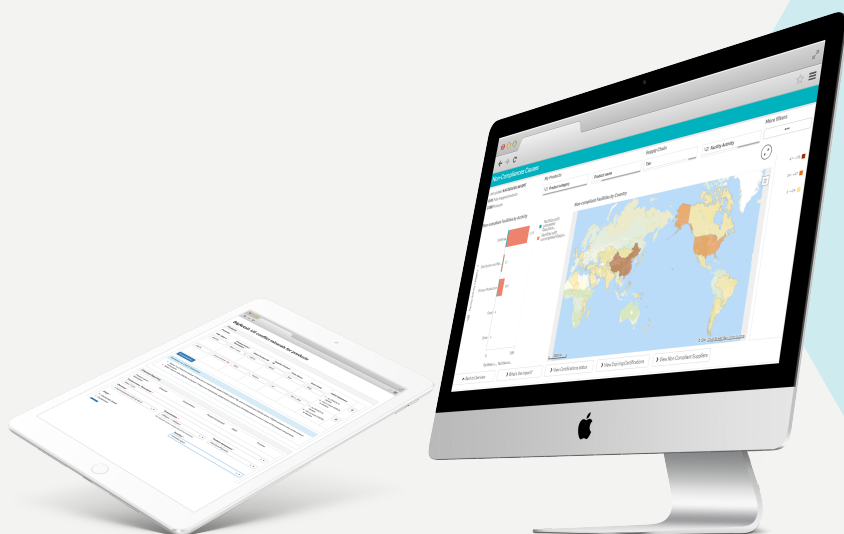
Transparency-One's chemical program encompasses two elements to help businesses ensure complete compliance:

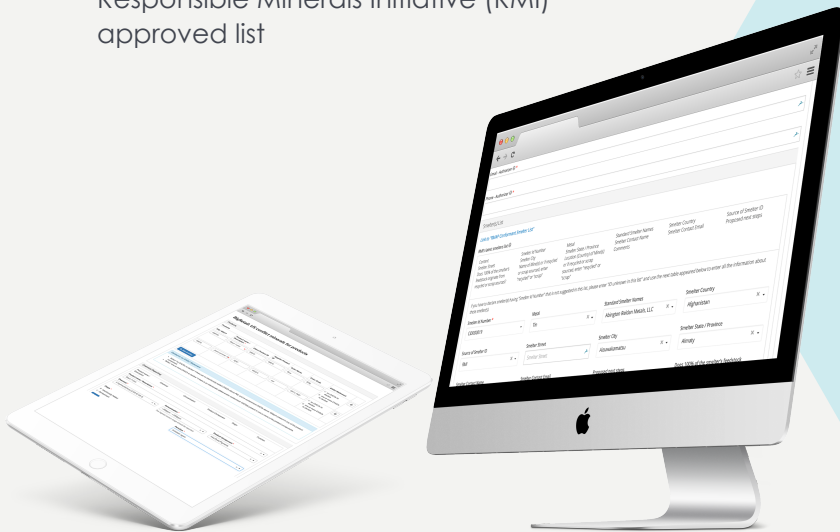

Conflict Minerals Program

Regulations such as the US Dodd Frank Act and Regulation EU 2017/821 require brands and retailers to know which of the four most common conflict minerals—tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold ore—can be found in their products.

Transparency-One's conflict minerals program encompasses two elements to help businesses ensure complete compliance:

- 1 Survey** to collect critical conflict mineral data, such as smelters, from suppliers
- 2 Reporting** to assess supplier compliance and compare declared smelters with Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) approved list



How It Works

- Create and communicate conflict mineral requirements in Transparency-One
- Assure supplier participation through onboarding support and introductory webinar training
- Check smelters' conformance with Responsible Minerals Assurance Process (RMAP) standards
- Check status on compliance with conflict minerals requirements
- Prepare template for Special Disclosure report
